

# Barrington Antiques & Auction Co. Sale In Warren, RI, February 26

WARREN R.I. — Ken and Amy Shaw, owners of Barrington Antique and Auction Company, are hosting an art and antiques auction on Saturday, February 26, at 4 pm. They have been in the auction business since 1987, and recently relocated to their new and spacious home — the American Tourister Building at 91 Main Street.

The firm will auction the estate of a prominent Providence, R.I., doctor. Said principal Ken Shaw, "We are offering the full contents of the estate, with additions." A landscape by American artist Mabel Woodward will be sold, as well as a portrait of a lady signed by Max Ehler. A KPM plaque depicting a mother and daughter in a gold leaf frame will cross the block.

Other paintings up for bid include a J.R. Carroll and a signed Leroy Neiman serigraph, a depiction of the America's Cup race. A paint-

ing by artist Fritz Sonderland, a depiction of a young boy, and a painting attributed to Bartolomé Esteban Murillo (1617-1682) of young dice players.

A rare Eighteenth Century receipt for a "Negro woman," as well as many old documents and ephemera will be offered at this sale. Old currency, including many old "star" notes, will be sold as part of this estate. There are some pieces of vintage jewelry, including an 18K "oro" 2.6-ounce bracelet and rings, including a diamond engagement ring with 36 nesting diamonds and a large center diamond.

Weapons to be offered include two Tanto daggers, two Japanese rifles, a Civil War sword and a Japanese



tsuba.

The sale will open with at 3 pm with furniture from an estate, as well as vintage brewery advertising signs, Christmas items, books, vintage radios and medical instru-

## Harry Orlyk, Marion Vinot To Open At Carrie Haddad

HUDSON, N.Y. — Carrie Haddad Gallery will present its newest exhibit featuring the work of two artists, Harry Orlyk and Marion Vinot, on view March 10-April 17. An opening reception with the artists will take place on Saturday, March 12, from 6 pm to 8 pm.

Harry Orlyk's work is continually on display at the gallery, but this will be the first exhibit of Vinot's work in more than a dozen years. Also presented will be a salon-style display of various gallery purchases, including Jim Dine and Donald Sultan, which will be on display and for sale in the back room.

Orlyk's plein air oil paintings are a selection of winter images

from 2010 to 2011. Snow scenes are a favorite for Orlyk, and the array of colors he uses in these paintings brings to mind the number of names the Inuits have for snow.

French-born Marion Vinot has gained recognition as an accomplished ceramicist, chef and painter. Her paintings are, primarily, portraits of women — women strolling, engaged in sports, cooking, napping or simply pondering life's possibilities.
